### **OUR MISSION**



Outside of South Africa, there are no certified or qualified welding schools in the African sub-continent. One of our first strategic goals is to support the development of up to 30 world class certified welding schools across Africa. To do this we have developed a \$100 million USD African Welding School and Training Program. This program will spark Africa's industrial revolution, leading to African countries becoming flowering centers of industry and prosperity.

### THE PROBLEM

African welding schools have not been upgraded since the era of colonial independence in the 1960's. They only teach ornamental welding, not the industrial skills-based training required to develop a welder who can produce competent structural welds for industries including agriculture, energy, mining, shipbuilding, and other industries. Resolving this issue will have a consequential effect by reducing the extreme poverty that results in annal child mortality rate of 3.2 million children per year.
